Pahoa Animal Hospital Elective Surgery Prices

All surgery prices include basic blood work and fluid therapy in order to promote your pet's health and minimize possible complications:

Blood work is to evaluate liver and kidney functions with complete blood counts to make sure your pet can safely be put under anesthesia.

Fluid therapy is to keep your pet hydrated and to keep blood pressure within the normal range during surgery. As a safety precaution - having the fluid IV line in place also provides the most efficient way to administer emergency medication.

Dental procedures:

A pre-dental exam is required for all dentals and is included in the price. We will provide a custom treatment plan for each pet based on the veterinarian's examination findings. The high-end price of dentals include full mouth X-rays. These X-rays, just like in human dentistry, are highly recommended to be able to access the health of each tooth.

The higher end of the price range is based on our wellness recommendations and your pet's needs. These can include go-home pain meds, antibiotics, an E-collar, heartworm test, fecal test, microchip and vaccinations.
