All surgery prices include basic blood work and fluid therapy in order to promote your pet's health and minimize possible complications:

Blood work is to evaluate liver and kidney functions with complete blood counts to make sure your pet can safely be put under anesthesia.

Fluid therapy is to keep your pet hydrated and to keep blood pressure within the normal range during surgery. As a safety precaution - having the fluid IV line in place also provides the most efficient way to administer emergency medication.

The higher end of the price range is based on our wellness recommendations and your pet's needs. These can include go-home pain meds, antibiotics, an E-collar, heartworm test, fecal test, microchip and vaccinations.
